



Sorting your waste at home will save you time at the recycling centre, money on waste management and help protect the environment for everyone.

Coleraine Borough Council's Recycling & Disposal Centres are available for use by the public free of charge. Business disposal of trade waste must use pre-paid Council bags or tags. For details please phone 028 7634 7272.

Below you will find details of the types of material accepted in each bin, bank or skip. It is important that you keep to these guidelines.

If you need any help please ask a member of staff.

## garden

Grass, leaves, hedge cuttings, small branches, weeds, plants, flowers, prunings. **NO PLASTIC BAGS**, no soil, no rubble. Garden waste is composted and sold by Conservation Volunteers. For details call 028 7695 6352.



## wood

Fencing, window frames (no glass), furniture (wooden frames only, no cloth, no upholstery, no foam etc), bar stools, **NO MISC.** Clean wood only, no plastic veneer, no tipples. Wood is used as boiler fuel.



## metal

Metal gates, doors, fencing, radiators etc. **Always** metal to be recycled into finished products, such as skirting, in quality.



## diy rubble

Bricks, blocks, concrete, asphalt and ceramics are crushed and used for road building.



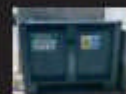
## electrical & electronic

All electrical and electronic equipment such as toasters, kettles, televisions and computers will be safely disposed of and recycled where possible.



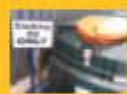
## car batteries

Plastic casing is recycled. Heavy metals and acids are disposed of safely.



## cooking oil

Cooking oil of **ONE** kind and used as fuel for vehicles.



## fluorescent light s

Fluorescent light tubes only, no other light tubes. Light tubes are disposed of safely.



## glass

Glass bottles and jars. Place green glass bottles and jars in the green bank, brown in the brown bank and clear in the white bank. Glass is recycled into new glass bottles and jars.



## paper

All paper including newspapers, magazines, post, envelopes (no plastic windows), flyers, telephone directories, brochures. Paper is recycled into egg boxes.



## cardboard

Cardboard boxes and cardboard packaging **ONLY**. **NO** polystyrene, **NO** plastics. Cardboard is made into new cardboard boxes and packaging.



## textile recycling

Please give a clearly **stapled** choice. Clothes bags vary - please read the label on the back. All clothes, textiles and shoes must be bagged to keep them dry.



## book & music

Good quality books, records, DVDs, CDs and videos are sold for reuse with the money going to charity.



## household batteries

Batteries are recycled into new batteries. As batteries take up to 10 times more energy to make than they release in their lifetime, please use re-chargeable batteries where possible.



## engine oil

Engine oil of **ONE** kind. Engine oil is cleaned and used as boiler fuel.



## fridges & freezers

The ozone depleting gases (FCG & HCFC) are safely removed from fridges and freezers before recycling where possible, and disposed.
